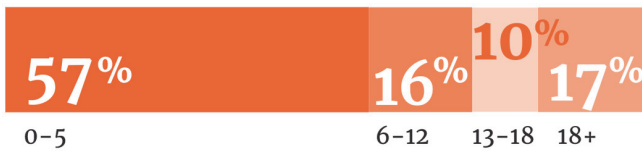

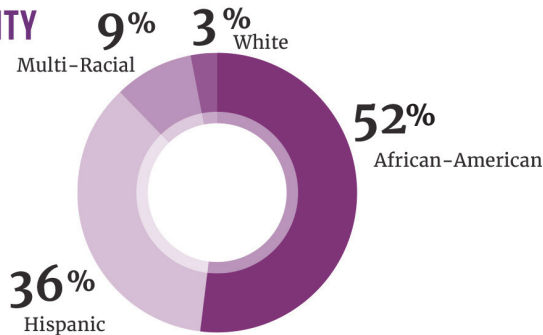

of participants had family incomes less than the federal poverty level. (Includes participants who are wards of the state who do not have an income)

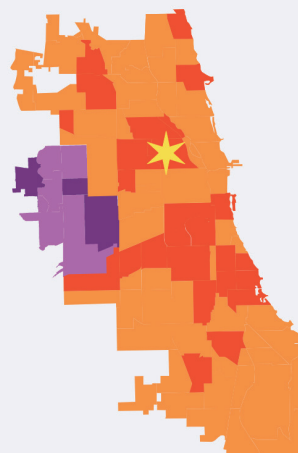


of participant families survive on annual incomes of \$20,000 or less.
